## 2021 ANNUAL REPORT

# Greetings!

As we concluded the year 2021, we were still dealing with the challenges of the COVID pandemic. Once again, we provided over \$2 million dollars in benevolent care. In fact, we provided \$2.7 million to those in our care who have limited funds. We are fortunate that through the years, our supportive donors have remembered Allegheny Lutheran Social Ministries (ALSM) as they completed their estate planning.

Again in 2021, most of our time focused on dealing with the obstacles of the COVID-19 pandemic as we complied with the precautions of our regulating bodies to enable the safety of our staff and residents. As we dealt with diminished census in our programs and campuses because of these regulations, as well as staffing limitations, we continued to follow our mission of service. Yet in spite of the pandemic, we accomplished the following:

- The cottage expansion continued on the campus of The Oaks at Pleasant Gap.
- The Annual Jim Meadows Memorial First Commonwealth Bank Golf Outing raised \$48,000.
- We again served more than 3,000 people in our programs that span the generations throughout the eight counties of West Central Pennsylvania.
- Our staff team members were recognized for their service during the pandemic.
- ALSM continued to be the only Lutheran not-for-profit organization that is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) in PA.

This update is a brief overview of ALSM's commitment to serve people. We are blessed that we have dedicated staff team members who respond every day to the needs of those persons we serve. We are also fortunate to have folks who support our mission.





An outdoor venue met one of the challenges of providing entertainment (now a preferred experience!) during the pandemic.




