PRE-K COUNTS EXPECTED OUTCOMES



- Children learn the letters of the alphabet; numbers and counting; shapes; and colors
- Children learn sight words and pre-reading skills
- Children build fine and gross motor skills through learning games and activities
- Children develop and refine self-help skills to help them be self-reliant and independent
- Children learn science concepts (such as needs of living things; weather; animals; magnets; etc.)
- Children develop mathematical thinking skills to help with counting, number recognition, understanding quantity and using simple functions like addition and subtraction.
- Children learn creative expression through art, storytelling, construction, dramatic play, etc.
